

Regulations of the photo competition with prizes "BioArt. From the cell to the body. "

I. Organizer and duration of the competition

1. The organizer of the "BioArt. From the cell to the body." photo competition, hereinafter referred to as "the Competition" is the Medical University of Lublin, hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer".

4. The competition will run from November 27, 2018 to January 20, 2019.
5. The Organizer reserves the right to extend the duration of the Competition beyond the deadline specified in point. 1.4., and will inform the participants of the Competition about that fact via the university website: www.umlub.pl and facebook of the university: www.facebook.com/UMLub24.

II. The goal and theme of the Competition

The aim of the competition is to present the work of beauty and diversity of biological objects: cells, cell structures, tissues, organs and whole living organisms. Photographs are to enable observation of these objects from new perspectives, which is why the participants of the Competition should take care primarily of visual and aesthetic attractiveness and originality. The next determinant of the evaluation of the works will be their educational character.

III. Competition's categories

There are two categories separated in the competition:

- a) **Category A - photos of biological objects, including research photos.** Research photographs are understood as the result of digitizing research data, among others in the form of bioimaging (eg. fluorescent, luminescent). The processing of images sent in this category may be based on basic modifications in terms of: cropping, contrasting, brightening and dimming, reducing and enhancing the color. **Photomontage, combining photos, removing / adding objects, etc. are forbidden.**
- b) **Category B - artistic photos** (photos of microorganisms used in the role of paints, collage of research photos, collage of photos of biological objects, etc.). The processing of images sent in this category may be the modifications in terms of: cropping, contrasting, brightening and dimming, reduction and color enhancement. **Photomontage, photo merging, adding / removing objects, etc. are allowed.**

IV. Technique of taking photos

In both categories, photos can be taken with any digital camera (smartphone, compact, DSLR, etc.) or with laboratory devices and systems (microscopes, x-ray machines, MRI, CT, PET, in vivo imaging systems and imaging of gels and blots).

V. Terms and participants of the competition

1. The competition is single-step.
2. The "BioArt" competition is addressed only to students of the Medical University of Lublin. Eligible for competition are students of all programs and levels including doctorate students.
3. The participant is obliged to present the original photo.
4. Participation in the competition is tantamount to acceptance of the terms of the competition.
5. Providing personal data, making statements, as well as granting all consents set out in the Regulations and declarations is voluntary, but necessary to accept a competition entry allowing participation in the Competition.

VI. Personal data

1. In connection with the registration of participation in the Competition, personal data is collected from persons filing such applications: name, surname, telephone number, e-mail address, course and year of study, album number.
2. Personal data contained in the application form is provided by the person reporting voluntarily. Their transfer is necessary for the purpose of processing, i.e. participation in the Competition.
3. Organizer: Medical University of Lublin, in the scope of organizing the Competition and processing data of its participants has the status of administrator and as the administrator of the personal data collection informs that the collected data are processed in accordance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free flow of such data and the repeal of Directive 95/46 / EC (the so-called: General Regulation on Personal Data Protection / RODO). Personal data will be processed only for the purpose of accepting the competition entry, participation in the Competition and its implementation, as well as statistical and archival purposes, as well as the setting and pursuing a possible claims. The basis for data processing is the consent of the person interested in participating in the Competition, i.e. art. 6 par. 1 point a of the General Regulation on the Protection of Personal Data.
4. The collected data will not be sold and disclosed to external entities, except for cases provided for by law, including those with which the Organizer will enter into appropriate agreements, e.g. in connection with the use of external services, including IT, it will also not be transferred to third countries and international organizations. It will be processed during the Competition and archiving documentation after the end of the Competition, in accordance with the law and procedures of the Organizer, and in the event of any claims in periods resulting from the provisions of common law. The person has the right to access his/her data, correct, transfer the data, cancel consent at any time, which will result in the lack of the possibility to participate in the Competition, without affecting the legality of the processing operations performed prior to the withdrawal of the consent, - in cases prescribed by law - demand restricting data processing or object to its processing, it also has the right to submit a complaint to the supervisory body, i.e. the President of the Office for the Protection of Personal Data. The data will not be used for any purpose other than those indicated above, no decisions in an automated manner will be made on the basis of the data, it will not be subject to profiling.

5. The Competition Organizer, as the data controller, has appointed a person supervising the area of personal data processing, being the Inspector of Personal Data Protection, who can be contacted at the following e-mail address: daneosobowe@umlub.pl.

VII. Submitting works

1. A prerequisite to participate in the Competition is to send to konkurs@umlub.pl:
 - a) competition picture
 - b) scan or photo of the completed and legibly signed contact form (annex No. 1)
 - c) scan or photo of the completed and legibly signed declaration of consents (annex No. 2)
 - d) scan or photo of a completed and legibly signed declaration on having exclusive copyrights and property rights to the photo (annex No. 3)
 - e) the following information should be included in the e-mail sent to the organizer's address:
 - personal data of the participant (name and surname),
 - competition category,
 - title of the photograph (maximum 40 characters including spaces),
 - description of the photo and a description of any modification of the photo (maximum 160 characters including spaces),
 - name of the Laboratory / Department where the picture was taken,
 - the name and model of the device with which the picture was taken,
 - JPG file is to be signed with the next photo number and the category according to the formula:
surname_ work number_ category, for example, Kowalski_1_A.
2. Submission of photographs to the competition takes place by sending a file in electronic form to the address konkurs@umlub.pl.
3. The submitted photos must be in JPG format, with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi and a size not exceeding 5 MB. If necessary, the participant will be notified of the need to send the photograph in a better resolution and format that allows for a good quality printout.
4. The participant may submit to the Competition a maximum of 3 individual entries in each category with the reservation that the participant can only win one prize in a given category for the highest evaluated photograph.
5. Submissions of entries/photographs will be accepted until January 20, 2019.
6. Photographs that do not meet the requirements of the Competition regulations will be rejected.

VIII. Evaluation of the work and the conclusion of the Competition

1. The Organizer will appoint a Competition Committee in order to assess the correctness of applications and select winners in the Competition.
2. The Competition Committee will select 6 winners of the Competition, 3 in each category.
3. Photos will be evaluated according to the following criteria:
 - a) visual and aesthetic attractiveness,
 - b) originality,
 - c) educational and scientific articulation.

4. The results of the Committee meetings are final and binding for all Competition participants.
5. Award winners will be notified by email until February 8, 2019.
6. The results of the Competition will be announced on the Organizer's website: www.umlub.pl and facebook: www.facebook.com/UMLub24.
7. Award ceremony is to take place until February 28, 2019.

IX. Prizes

1. The following prizes are provided:
 - a) E-reader and book prize for 1st place in each category,
 - b) book prize for 2nd place in each category,
 - c) gadgets set with Zeiss logo for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each category,
 - d) gadgets set with University logo for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each category.
2. The sponsors of the Competition are Eduson.pl (e-reader and book prizes), Zeiss (gadgets sets with Zeiss logo and book prizes) and Organizer.
3. Participants of the Competition are not entitled to claim for payment of the value of the prizes or exchange of the awarded prize for another prize.
4. The organizer reserves the right to award fewer prizes or withdraw from granting them if there are not enough applications.

X. Copyrights for competition photos

1. Participant of the Competition declares that:
 - a) He/she is entitled to personal copyrights and unlimited property rights to the photograph, as well as he/she can freely dispose of these rights and use them,
 - b) He/she is entitled to the copyrights that do not endanger and do not violate the rights of third parties, in particular, without violating their property and personal rights.
2. In the event of a third party presenting claims resulting from infringement of the rights set out in the declaration (annex 2), the participant of the Competition who submitted the photograph covered by the claim, bears full financial responsibility before the Organizer and third parties and compensates the Competition Organizer, as solely responsible, the costs incurred in connection with compensation claims against him.
3. Participation in the Competition is tantamount to consenting to multiple, free publishing of photos on the website, facebook, instagram and on the Organizer's youtube channel, and in the Organizer's printed materials, including the Alma Mater quarterly of the publishing house - Wydawnictwo Uniwersytetu Medycznego in Lublin.
4. On the day of entering the Competition, the participant grants the Organizer a non-exclusive license for photographs submitted as part of the Competition without time limitations, quantitative and territorial restrictions in the following fields of exploitation:
 - a) in terms of preservation and multiplication by all techniques, including printing, reprographic, magnetic recording, digital, audiovisual, on any media, without any restrictions as far as the size of the print run,
 - b) in terms of the dissemination, placing on the market, public performance or public display, public show,
 - c) in terms of placing into the computer memory and presentation on the Internet
 - d) in terms of broadcasting via wired vision, wireless and via satellite
 - e) in terms of editorial and computer processing

5. The participant authorizes the Organizer to decide on the meaning, the way of marking or the lack of marking the photos.
6. Participants are not entitled to any remuneration for using the photos by the Medical University of Lublin.

XI. Final Provisions

1. The Competition Regulations are available on the website www.umlub.pl.
2. In matters not covered by these regulations, the relevant provisions of Polish law shall apply.
3. Regulations come into force on the day of signing.
