Wenzhou Medical University (WMU) was established in 1958 and has the total enrollment of 24,809 in 2023. As one of the leading independent medical universities in China, it boasts 5 directly-affiliated hospitals and 29 non-directly affiliated teaching hospitals. It ranks the 501-600 in the 2023 ARWU Academic Ranking of World Universities, 9th among Chinese medical universities.

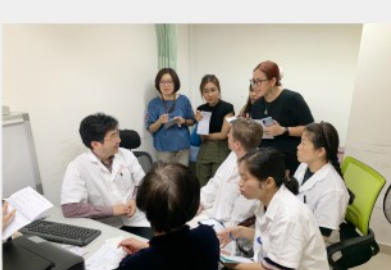
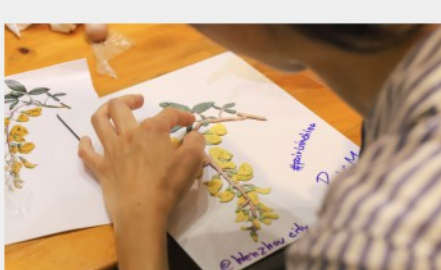
### Eligibility

Recommendation letter from your current university for getting nominated to join this summer program.

Applicants whose native language is not English speaking should provide the scanned color copies of proof of English proficiency test.

Ordinary passport within the validity period (Scanned color copy).

Other supplementary documents required by WMU.

#### Step 3

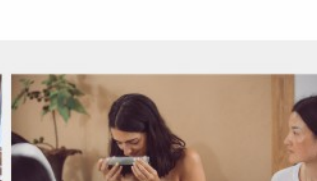
Check your email frequently for the Visa Application Form for Study in China (DQ Form) (Note: The admission standard is receiving the DQ Form).
